

Observations and Corrective Actions

Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below, or as stated in sections 8-405.11 of the food code.

- 6 FYI: 15A NCAC 18A .2652 ref. 2-401.12(A-C): Food employees shall wash hands and exposed portions of arms using an approved cleaner for at least 20 seconds Food employees shall use the following cleaning procedure... (1) Rinse under clean, warm water; (2) Apply soap; (3) Rub vigorously for 10-15 seconds creating friction and also addressing areas under fingernails and between fingers; (4) Thoroughly rinse under clean, running warm water (5) Dry hands with approved method and turning off faucets in approved manner that avoids recontamination.
- 20 Two pizza pies from previous night had been left in hot holding unit. According to management, pizzas are not left and this was a mistake from closing employees. / Small package of turkey measured 51°F on make top. This was not in a recessed bin. Foods will not maintain proper temperature of 45°F or less when not completely recessed in bins. Do not double stack bins in unit.
- 21 Date marking system in place and approximately 80% in compliance. Remember to date mark processed cheese after opening not to extend 7 day expiration. Date opening is considered day 1.
- 38 Food employee observed with unapproved jewelry on wrist. 15A NCAC 18A .2652 ref. 2-303.11: Except for a plain ring such as a wedding band, while preparing food, food employees may no wear jewelry on their arms or wrists 15A NCAC 18A .2652 ref. 2-402.11 (A): Food employees shall wear hair restraints such as hats, hair coverings or nets, beard restraints, and clothing that covers body hair, that are designed and worn to effectively keep their hair from contacting exposed food; clean equipment, utensils, and linens; and unwrapped single-service and single-use articles 15A NCAC 18A .2652 ref. 2-302.11 (B): Unless wearing intact gloves in good repair, a food employee may not wear fingernail polish or artificial fingernails when working with exposed food



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Observations and Corrective Actions

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- 43 Bar straws in stations accessible to customers in cafe and at bar. Exposed plastic eating utensils not all facing with handle side exposed to customer at cafe. One small stack of cups exposed outside of holster, all other with shipping sleeve extended. 15A NCAC18A .2654 ref. 4-904.11 (A): Single-service and single-use articles shall be handled, displayed, and dispensed so that contamination of food- and lip-contact surfaces is prevented. (C): Single-service articles that are intended for food- or lip-contact shall be furnished for consumer self-service with the original individual wrapper intact or from an approved dispenser.
- 45 Wooden shelving has been removed from walk in cooler. Other repeat violations: reseal peeling laminate cabinetry, front edge of shelving in many reach in units are beginning to rust and must be replaced or recoated with an approved foodservice equipment paint; Replace torn cooler gaskets (like 2 door reach in, small reach in freezer, etc.); replace missing rollcart leg caps).
- 47 Clean shelving in walk in cooler (Repeat Violation) and dusty wall mounted shelving. Clean metal roll carts. Clean single service holsters (plastic cutlery/plastic lids, etc.)(Repeat Violations) / Clean pizza pan storage area.
- 53 Vinyl composition tiles on floors are separating in areas of the kitchen and must be reset and sealed to create cleanable surfaces. Tile is damage beyond repair at pizza make and must be replaced. Wall tiling is missing left of pizza oven. Vinyl baseboard is peeling or missing from walls in walk in unit and must be replaced or resealed.
- 54 Repeat Violations: Lighting measures below the required minimum 50 foot candles (fc) in the following areas: grill line and make unit (5-20fc), central prep table (19fc), pizza make (25fc), and prep sink (27fc). Lighting is below the minimum 20fc at the all bar warewashing and beer tap surfaces (17-18fc), cookline handsink (15fc), both women and men's restroom handsinks (10-15fc), urinals (10-12fc), first men's stall (13fc), and other stalls in women's restroom where a light fixture is not overhead (15fc). Lighting is below the require minimum 10fc in the walk in cooler (0fc). Increase lighting.
