## Observations and Corrective Actions

Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below, or as stated in sections 8-405.11 of the food code.

- 16 Final cook temperature of grilled chicken was 152F. Chicken was returned to grill for more cooking and then measured 169F-176F. CDI

- 23 Currently, most of the food items that can be served undercooked have a disclosure and a reminder; however, steaks are not denoted. Ensure that food items that are not labeled whole-muscle, intact beef are denoted.  
3-603.11 Consumption of Animal Foods that are Raw, Undercooked, or Not Otherwise Processed to Eliminate Pathogens
- 35 A pan with bottles of unlabeled oils and ingredients was on a shelf on the grill line. Label all working containers and bulk foods removed from their original packaging with the common name of the food.

Only a plain ring may be worn while preparing food. / Employees must keep fingernails maintained so that they are cleanable. Unless wearing intact gloves, a food employee may not wear fingernail polish or artificial fingernails when working with food.

- 39 Wet wiping cloth containers were on the floor throughout the facility. Store containers off of the floor. One container was on a prep table. Store containers in a manner that prevents contamination of food, equipment, utensils, linens, single service, or single use items. There was a small amount of sanitizing solution in the wet wiping cloth container. Cloths in use for wiping must be held between uses in a chemical sanitizer solution. Add more sanitizing solution so that all of the cloths are in the sanitizer.

- 45 There were a few torn gaskets on the doors of pull out drawers and reach in coolers. Repair or replace torn gaskets as needed. / There is a condensation leak in the freezer that has caused the door to build up condensation. Repair. / The prep table at the main wait station does not meet NSF standards. Contact the manufacturer. /
- 47 Equipment cleaning is needed on doors and gaskets.
- 53 Repair the ceiling in the single service closet. The ceiling has damage. / There are small holes in the walls throughout the facility. Repair. The wall by the dish machine is soiled. Clean. / In the walk in cooler, the baseboard tile is separating from the wall. Repair.
- 54 Lighting in the restrooms is low. 6-10 foot candles at the urinals and toilets in the men's room. 10-15 foot candles at the toilets in the women's restroom. Lighting in these areas must be at least 20 foot candles.
