## Observations and Corrective Actions

Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below, or as stated in sections 8-405.11 of the food code.

- 20 3-501.16 (A)(2) and (B) Potentially Hazardous Food (Time/Temperature Control for Safety Food), Hot and Cold Holding - P Repeat violation. Cheese at front prep station 42-44F. Cheese in front worktop cooler 42F. Air temp of worktop 42F. Potentially hazardous food shall be cold held at 41F or less. CDI. Both cheeses relocated to walk in cooler. Worktop cooler may not be used to store sliced cheese until it has been repaired to maintain food temperatures of 41F or less..
- 26 7-201.11 Separation-Storage - P 0 points. Can of air freshener stored next to pan of lids for iced tea containers. Poisonous or toxic materials shall be stored so they cannot contaminate food, equipment, utensils, linens, and single-service and single-use articles.- CDI. Air freshener relocated to bottom storage shelf.
- 43 4-903.11 (A) and (C) Equipment, Utensils, Linens and Single-Service and Single-Use Articles-Storing - C 0 points. Sleeve containing disposable coffee cups stored next to hand sink where it can be contaminated by drip from reaching for paper towels. Note:proper splash guard in place. Once sleeves are opened, store cups on right side of coffee maker where they will be protected. CDI. Open sleeves of cups relocated.

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- 45 4-501.11 Good Repair and Proper Adjustment-Equipment - C Repeat violation(with improvements made) many gaskets replaced/realigned. Rusted shelving in dish area replaced. Identify a repair solution for door of walk in cooler that does not seal properly and is causing ice buildup inside the freezer. Continue equipment improvements by replacing missing handles/knobs on equipment throughout. Recondition/replace rusted fan cover in small cooler near flat top. Recondition lower shelves and legs of prep tables and sinks where they are oxidized. Remove cardboard liner from shelving as it is neither durable nor easily cleanable. Equipment shall be in good repair.
- 47 4-601.11 (B) and (C) Equipment, Food-Contact Surfaces, Nonfood-Contact Surfaces, and Utensils - C Repeat violation(with improvements made). Additional cleaning needed on gaskets of refrigeration units throughout. Remove grese buildup from casters of equipment, especially in fryer area. Non food contact surfaces of equipment shall be clean.
- 53 6-501.11 Repairing-Premises, Structures, Attachments, and Fixtures-Methods - C Repeat violation(with improvements made). Rusted ceiling vents and damaged ceiling tiles throughout facility have been reconditioned or replaced. Repair damaged laminate and seal panels of equipment to be smooth and easily cleanable along front prep line. Coved base needed in walk in chicken cooler. Seal all ceiling/wall penetrations throughout facility. Physical facilities shall be in good repair.  
6-501.12 Cleaning, Frequency  
and Restrictions - C Floor cleaning needed under shelving and equipment. Physical facilities shall be clean.
