- 4 2-401.11 Eating, Drinking, or Using Tobacco - C Employee beverage stored on a prep table in the kitchen. All other beverages properly stored. Ensure employee beverages are covered and stored under or away from food.
- 8 6-301.12 Hand Drying Provision - PF Disposable towels found at the hand sink. Ensure trash receptacle is available for disposal of towels.
- 14 4-601.11 (A) Equipment, Food-Contact Surfaces, Nonfood-Contact Surfaces, and Utensils - P
 4-703.11 Hot Water and Chemical-Methods - P
 Wedger, tongs, and thermometer needed additional cleaning. Wash, rinse, and sanitize dishes properly to remove food debris and grime. Chlorine sanitizer weak in the 3 comp. sink vat and bottles. Ensure that the chlorine sanitizer is maintained at 50-200 ppm. Dishes sent for rewashing and sanitizer corrected during inspection.

- 47 4-601.11 (B) and (C) Equipment, Food-Contact Surfaces, Nonfood-Contact Surfaces, and Utensils - C Detailed equipment cleaning is needed on legs, sides, on top and underneath equipment. Detailed cleaning is needed on racks, shelves, inside refrigeration, and tables. Clean shelf where tea whip is stored.

- 49 5-204.12 Backflow Prevention Device, Location - C Ensure backflow prevention is installed at the tea and coffee urn.

- 51 5-501.17 Toilet Room Receptacle, Covered - C Ensure receptacle with covered lid is provided in the women's restroom.

- 52 5-501.110 Storage Refuse, Recyclables and Returnables - C Recyclables stored outside in cardboard boxes. Keep recyclables stored in container with doors or tight fitting lids.
