Observations and Corrective Actions

Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below, or as stated in sections 8-405.11 of the food code.

- 31 3-501.15 Cooling Methods - PF Repeat. Cooked pasta (spiral shaped) 54 F covered in a deep, plastic container filled to the top inside the walk in cooler. Cooling shall be accomplished by using one or more of the following methods: 1. Shallow pans, 2. Smaller or thinner portions, 3. Rapid cooling equipment, 4. Stir the food in container placed in an ice water bath, 5. Use containers that facilitate heat transfer, 6. Add ice as ingredient or 7. Other effective methods. In cold holding equipment, food shall be: 1. Arranged to provide maximum heat transfer and 2. Loosely covered or uncovered if protected from overhead contamination. CDI: Employee placed the pasta on a sheet pan into the walk in cooler.
- 45 4-501.11 Good Repair and Proper Adjustment-Equipment - C Caps missing on the floor panels causing debris inside located in the walk in freezer. Equipment shall be maintained in good repair.
 //4-502.11 (A) and (C) Good Repair and Calibration-Utensils and Temperature and Pressure Measuring Devices - C Cracked with separation on tray used for to store food. Cracked (not smooth) plastic container on the shelf. UTENSILS shall be maintained in a state of repair or condition that complies with the requirements specified under Parts 4-1 and 4-2 or shall be discarded.
- 47 4-601.11 (B) and (C) Equipment, Food-Contact Surfaces, Nonfood-Contact Surfaces, and Utensils - C Debris/residue along the surrounding edges of the floor inside the walk in freezer. Nonfood-contact surfaces of equipment shall be free from the accumulation of dust, dirt, food residue and other debris.

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- 51 6-501.18 Cleaning of Plumbing Fixtures - C Dried yellowish residue on the underneath of the urinal in the men's restroom. PLUMBING FIXTURES such as HANDWASHING SINKS, toilets, and urinals shall be cleaned as often as necessary to keep them clean.
- 54 6-303.11 Intensity-Lighting - C Repeat. Lighting measured 8 to 14 foot candles at the toilets in the women's restroom and 5 to 10 foot candles at the toilets/urinals in the men's restroom. Continue working on the lighting in the restrooms. Lighting measured low in the following areas: 10 to 14 foot candles at the dressing area for the self-service salad bar and 10 to 12 foot candles for single-use articles in storage area. Light bulb out in the fixture at the salad bar and single-use article storage area. Lighting shall be at least 215 lux (20 foot candles); at a surface where FOOD is provided for CONSUMER self-service such as buffets and salad bars or where fresh produce or PACKAGED FOODS are sold or offered for consumption and at a distance of 75 cm (30 inches) above the floor in areas used for handwashing, WAREWASHING, and EQUIPMENT and UTENSIL storage, and in toilet rooms.
